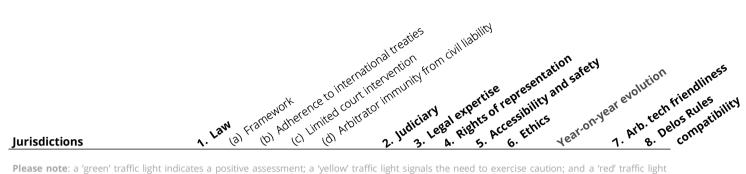
## GAP TRAFFIC LIGHTS FOR ALL JURISDICTIONS
